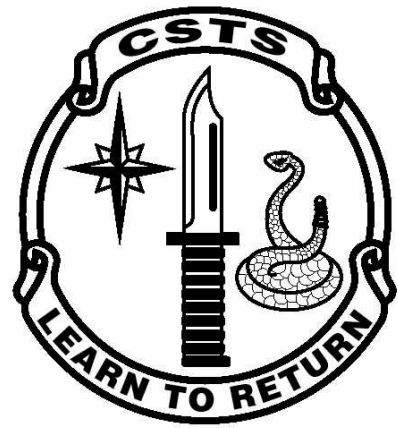

Bigger and better than ever, the school begins with comprehensive survival instruction in the classroom with day trips to an obstacle course, Leadership Reaction Course, land navigation, water survival and mountain repelling. Each student is issued a survival kit with all the contents needed when they go into the field to practice what was taught -- for 4 days and nights! The curriculum for CSTS is based on actual US military survival schools; the CSTS textbooks are current US Army, Air Force, and Navy issue. All senior members have either taught at, or graduated from a military survival school. Cadet leadership positions are held only by those who are CSTS graduates. This school will be tough; it is both academically and physically demanding. Each application will be evaluated by a review board prior to acceptance to the school. Only 30 slots are available. Do you have what it takes? Are you up to the challenge?
