SUBJECT: Application Announcement for CTG Executive Cadre (Suspense: 25 January 15)

- 1. The 2015 California Wing Encampment Commander Lieutenant Colonel Peggy Myrick invites eligible cadets to apply for the following executive cadre positions at the 2015 CAWG Encampment:
 - a. Commander, The Cadet Training Group (CTG)
 - b. Deputy Commander, CTG
 - c. Executive Officer, CTG
 - d. Superintendent, CTG
 - e. Cadet Safety Officer
 - f. Commander, Cadet Training Squadron (CTS); three or four positions available (depending on student application count)
- 2. All interested applicants should go to www.cawgencampment.com for application instructions. Applications will be accepted through the online registration system, no payment will be required nor signatures on CAP forms, though you will be asked to upload a cover letter and separate resume. Your resume should include your experiences (Civil Air Patrol and otherwise) that you feel apply to this Encampment and have prepared you for the job for which you are applying.
- 3. The deadline for completed applications is <u>Sunday</u>, <u>JANUARY 25</u>, <u>2015</u>. Applicants will receive receipt of their application upon submission. Following the deadline passage, applicants will be contacted to schedule interviews at the annual Cadet Programs Conference (CPC) to be held at Camp San Luis Obispo on Friday, February 13th through Sunday, February 15th. Simultaneously, applicants will be required to complete an additional assignment prior to their interview (ample time and instructions will be provided).
- 4. Applicants should have an understanding of Encampment related documents such as: CAPR 52-16, CAPP 52-24, CAWGOI 52-16-1 (updated 2014).

- 5. Successful candidates should be prepared to participate in the general Cadre Selection Exercise (CSX) scheduled for 15-17 May 2015, and will be asked to participate in two Executive Staff Retreats which will be scheduled based on group availability. Of course, you will also be expected to attend Encampment scheduled for 1-8 July 2015, as well as Pre-Encampment beginning on Sunday June 28th.
