1. It's my pleasure to inform you we have accepted you as a student at the 2003-2004 Cadet Officer's Basic Course. You're about to begin one of the most challenging and rewarding experiences California Wing has to offer.
2. COBC will begin at 1200, 27 December, at Naval Air Station, Lemoore. The course is scheduled to end by 1530, 3 January 2004. Inprocessing is scheduled from 0900 to 1200 on the 27th. Based on your travel plans, you may arrive as early as 1500 on the 26th, but the staff will be unavailable for detailed assistance until the 27th. The closest airport is Fresno (FYI). Although we would like everyone to arrive at Lemoore, we can make special arrangements for transportation from the airport, if needed. We'll also have special transportation available on a limited basis for out-of-state students who fly into Los Angeles International (LAX). Please contact LtCol Mark Williams at (310) 378-1191 immediately if you need airport pickup, or have special considerations. When you get to Lemoore, please go to the billeting office for directions.
3. Attached to this memo is a suggested equipment list. Please note – this list is provided for your planning and is just a guideline. Since the course is a week in duration, prepare accordingly. And remember, security of valuables is your own responsibility, so be careful.

- *Service uniform* (2 sets) consisting of: short-sleeve light blue shirt or blouse; dark blue trousers, skirt, or slacks; belt; flight cap; black shoes; socks or hose; and insignia

- *Camouflage fatigue uniform* (1 set) (woodland camouflage BDUs) consisting of: shirt, trousers, belt, baseball cap, combat boots, t-shirt, and insignia
